No.GVN-2020 (02)RCT-1816-3185-D.2 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Surveyor, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Forest Department, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Surveyor, Class III in the subordinate service of the Forest Department, Recruitment Rules, 2020.
2. Appointment to the post of Surveyor, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Forest Department shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,
(a) not be less than 18 years and not more than 33 years of age :

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

- (b) possess;
- (i) a diploma in Civil Engineering obtained from Technical Examination Board or from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or
 - (ii) a certificate of minimum one year course of Surveyor obtained from Industrial Training Institute;
- (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (d) possess minimum physical standards as specified in the Appendix; and
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The provisions of rule 9 A of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in respect of a candidate appointed by direct selection.
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to successfully undergo walking test of 25 kms in case of male candidate and 14 kms in case of female candidate in four hours:
- Provided that in case the candidate who has been called for appearing in the walking test, either fails to complete the walking test within prescribed time limit or fails to appear in
