2 CONSTITUTION OF FORESTS

2.1 FOREST AREA

The entire forest area in Gujarat State is 21820.12 Km². (As on 31st March 2015). This constitutes approximately 11% to total geographical area (196024 Km²) of Gujarat state. This forest area is constituted in 6 territorial, one social forestry and 4 wildlife circle. It also include a small area of Indroda Nature Park under GEER Foundation Gandhinagar. **(Statement-1)**

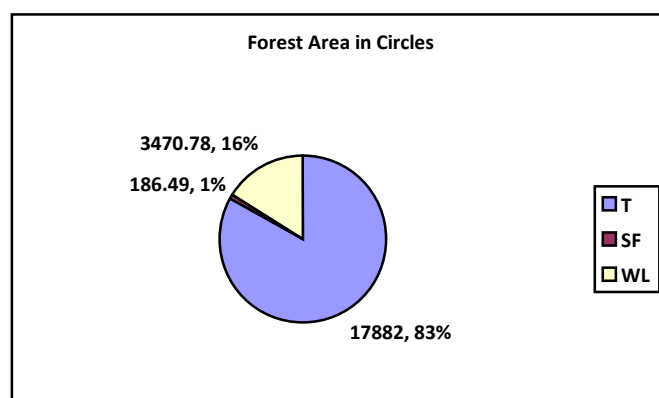


Figure 1: Forest Area in charge of different wings

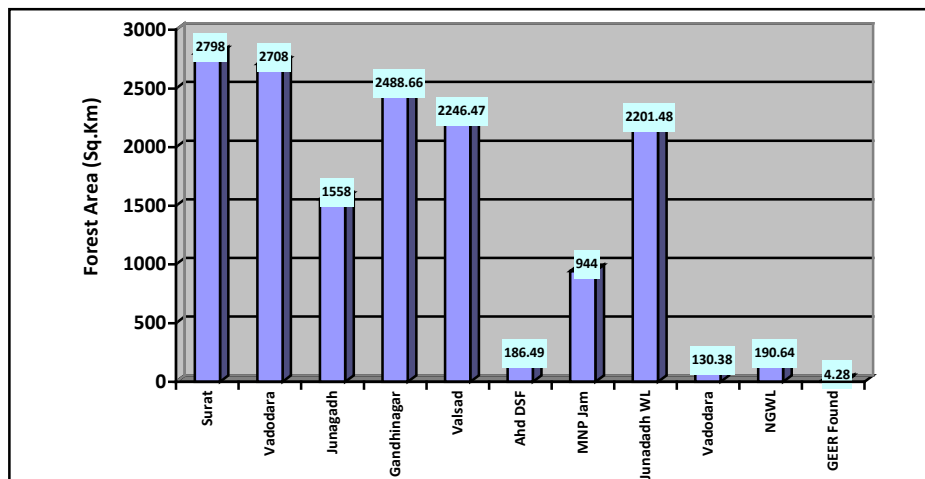


Figure 2: Forest Area under different Circles

2.2 AREA UNDER ROAD SIDE, CANAL SIDE, RAILWAY SIDE

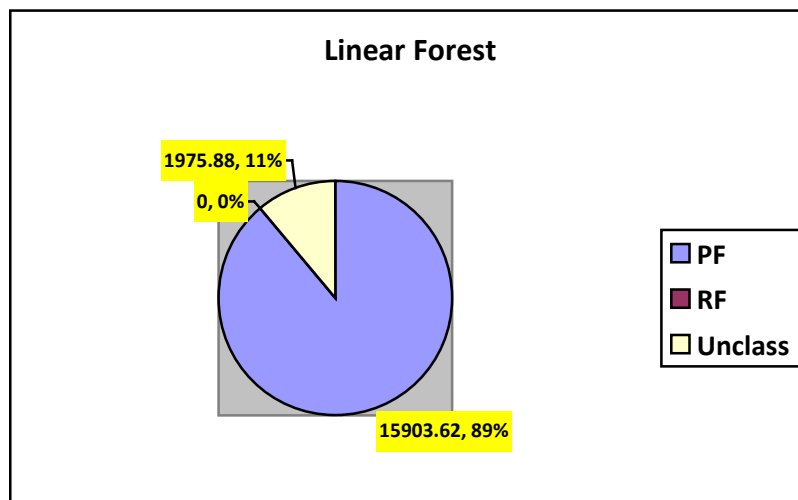


Figure 3: Linear Forests

At the beginning of the year, an area of 2341.74 Sq.km. was on hand for settlement. During the year 2014-2015, the settlement was carried out in an area of 958.52 Sq.km. **(Statement -2)**

2.4 DEMARCATION

During the Year 2014-2015, total length of the demarcated boundaries where boundary marks have been created was 16110.73 km. out of which boundary marks in 6435.05 km. were repaired and the marks in 8383.19 km were not repaired and boundary marks in 1292.49 km. (length) were demarcated during the year under this report. Total 3136.39 km. boundary remained to be demarcated at the close of the year and only 1187.78 km. of boundary did not require demarcation. Therefore the total length of the boundary at the close of the year remained 20434.89 km. **(Statement -3)**

2.5 SURVEY OF FOREST AREAS

During the year 2014-2015, there was no area surveyed by the Survey of India. The area of 3679.08 Sq.km remained to be surveyed. **(Statement -4)**

3 FOREST MANAGEMENT AND EXPLOITATION

3.1 FOREST MANAGEMENT AND REGULATION

During the year area under sanctioned working plan was 19875.81 Sq.km. Area requiring working plan was 164.44 Sq.km. and the area for which the plan is under preparation is 0.00 sq.km. Therefore the total area covered or was to be covered under working plan was 19875.81 sq.km, which is about 91.09% of the total forest area of the state. (Statement-5)

3.2 FOREST COUPES WORKING.

During the year 2014-15 in all 84 forest coupes were harvested, out of which 79 coupes were allotted to Forest Labour Cooperative Societies (FLCS) for harvesting and remaining 5 coupes were harvested departmentally.

Out of the 9722 cases disposed off during the year, 6668 cases were compounded departmentally, while 16 cases were disposed off by the court. 3.15 JOINT FOREST MANAGEMENT

Govt. of Gujarat has initiated Joint Forest Management (JFM) programme in the State in the year 1991 for the rehabilitation of degraded forests. This new concept was initially introduced in Bharuch, Surat, Vadodara and Panchmahal districts and thereafter it has been extended to Sabarkantha, Valsad, Banaskantha and Gandhinagar districts. As per Govt. of Gujarat F& E Deptt. GR JFM/201005-191-G Dt.17-12-2005, the JFM activities are extended even on good forest area i.e. above 0.4 density area with a specific condition of net profit distribution between Government and JFM at 80:20 ratio in place of 50 : 50 as was specified for areas below 0.4 density.

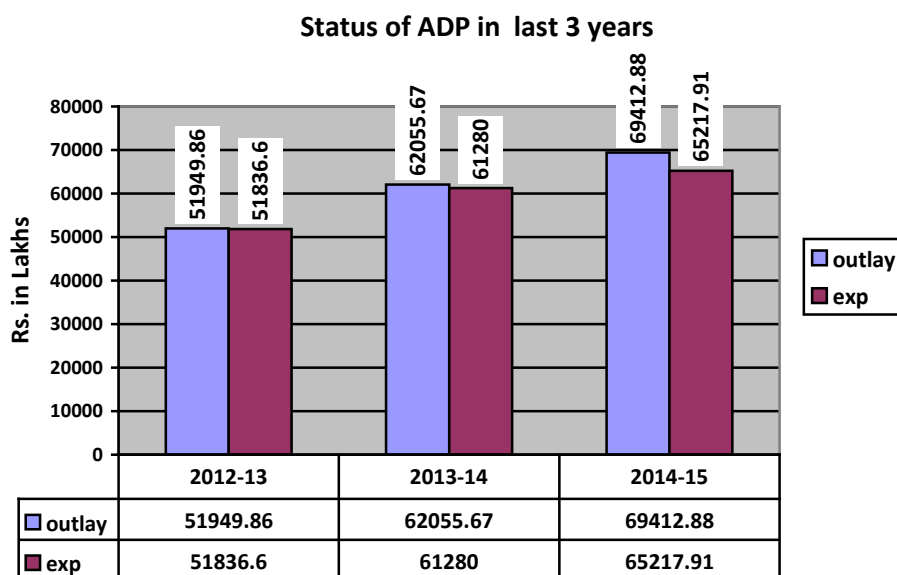
The JFM approach, has resulted in improvement in tree cover in many forest areas. To support the JFM villages, the much needed development works are carried out by availing funds from other sources. These activities are popularly known as Entry Point Programme / Activities. There has been significant progress in the field of JFM in recent times with total No. of 3415 JFMC have been formed, out of which 2418 have been registered. 4 TARGETS AND ACHIEVEMENTS UNDER ANNUAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

The total outlay for the Annual Development Plan 2014-2015 was Rs. 69412.88 lakh. As against this outlay, the total expenditure for the year was Rs. 65217.91 lakh, which works out to 99.99 % of the total plan outlay of the Forest Department which is 1.45% of the total State outlay. The expenditure under Tribal Area Sub-Plan was Rs. 22103.81 lakh. The scheme wise details of the progress during the year are given below.



4.1 DIRECTIONS AND ADMINISTRATION

During the year 2014-15, Rs. 1090.99 lakh has been incurred as against the outlay of Rs.1080.73 lakh for continuation of staff and fire protection works.

The schemes included under this group are (1) Development of Communication and (2) Construction of Buildings (3) Information & Technology. The total outlay provided was Rs. 1298.00 lakh and the expenditure was Rs. 812.51 lakh, which includes construction and maintenance of roads/causeways and construction of staff quarters/ seed store and maintenance of buildings.

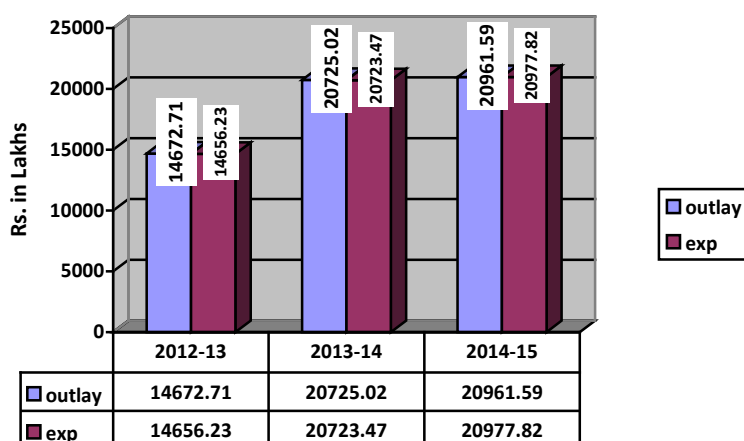

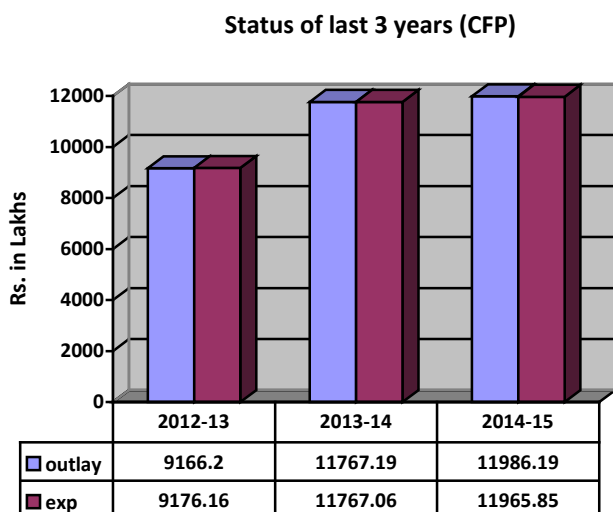

plantation maintenance works of 16418 ha. Total seedling distributed during 2014-15 was 610 lakhs. As against this, expenditure incurred was Rs.11965.85 Lakh during the year for achieving the targets.



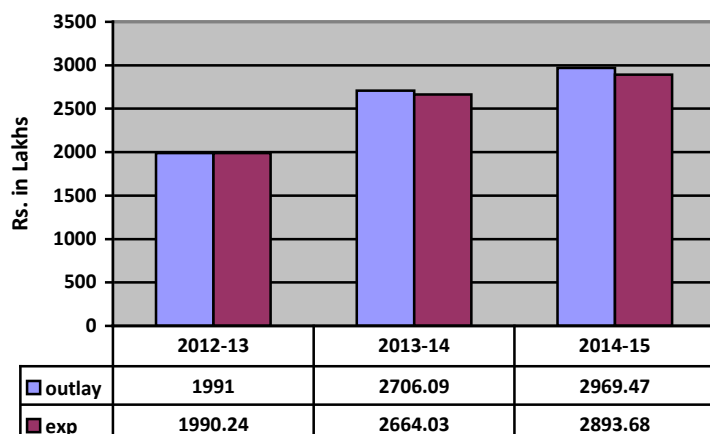

Trend of last 3 years (TRO)



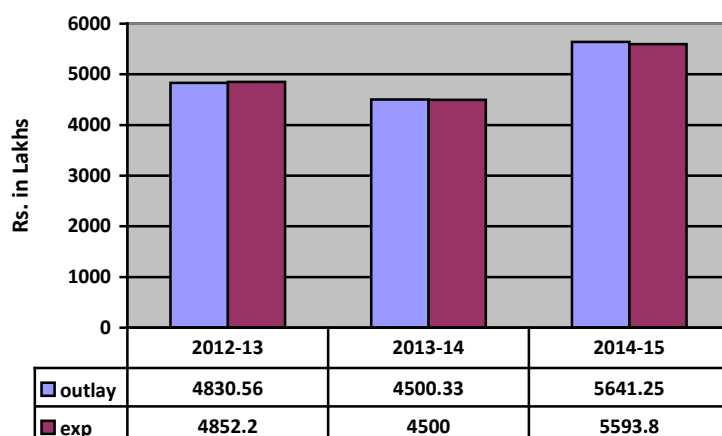

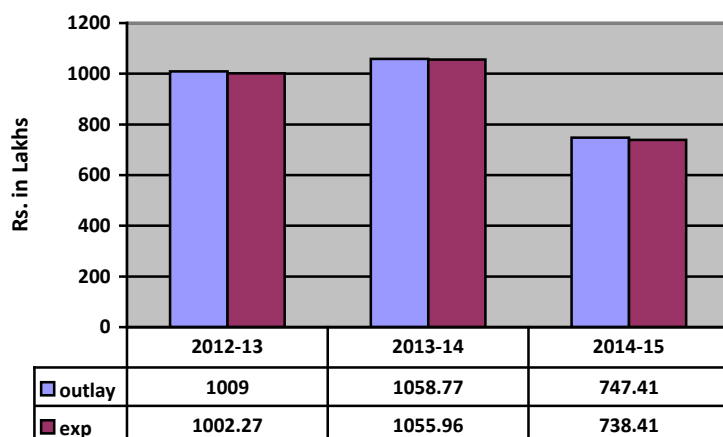

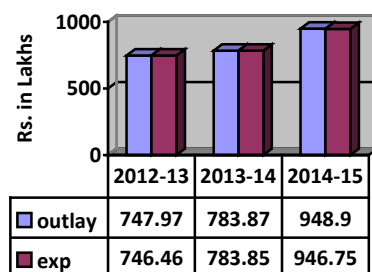
Trend of last 3 years (CA)

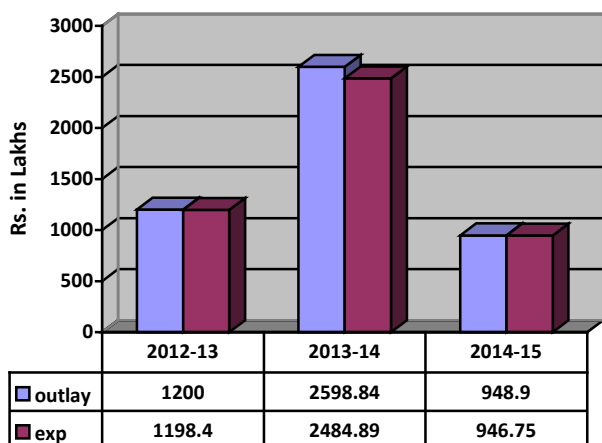
Status of last 3 years

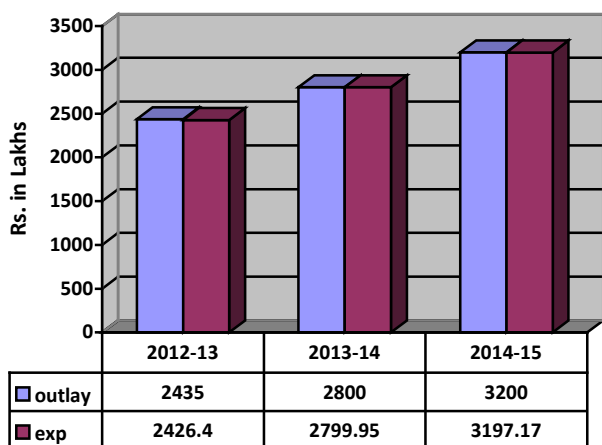
Trend of last 3 years (13-FC)

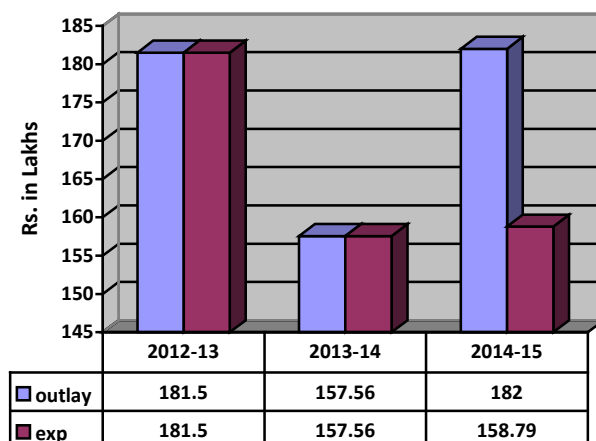
Trend of last 3 years (SCP)

Trend of last 3 years (Earmarked-TASP)



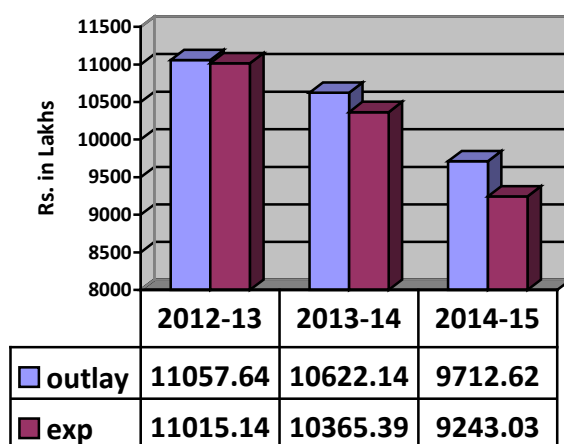

the Point No. 51 (B) 945.10 lakh target for seedling plantation was given for the year 2014-2015. Against this, the achievement was 1820.39 lakh which is about 192.61% of the annual target.

5.1 THE TOTAL VALUE OF FOREST PRODUCTS

5.3 TOTAL REVENUE & EXPENDITURE

The total revenue received under different budget heads during the year was Rs.4669.82 lakh. Whereas the total expenditure of the forest department during the year was Rs.102567.21 lakh., which constitutes Rs.64829.70 lakh as plan expenditure & Rs. 37737.51 lakh as non plan expenditure. (**Statement-13**).

5.4 OUTSTANDING RECOVERIES

The outstanding recoveries of the forest circles at the beginning of the year 2014-15 were Rs. 997.55 lakh and Rs. 757.06 lakh remaining at the end of the year. (**Statement-14**).

6 SOCIAL FORESTRY

Gujarat is a highly developed state of India where, approximately 10% geographical area of the state is legally designated as forests. The forests are irregularly distributed and confined mainly to the eastern and southern district of the state. The situation is aggravated by absence of tree cover from about half of the area. On the other hand, the climate and rainfall of state are quite varied. Agro-climatically the state is divided in to 8 agro-climate Zones. The rains are undependable and drought arte quite common (about 35% of the area is chronically affected). Fodder becomes scare during years and the state has to transport large quantities of fodder from far-off places to save the cattle from starvation. Promotion of tree planting on non-forest lands has been considered to be the only answer to improve the situation in the state. The Gujarat Forest Department, therefore, put forth a Social Forestry Programme for planting trees on all types of vacant lands. Under this programme, tree planting is carried out on the following categories of lands :

(A) GOVERNMENT LAND :

- (1) Strip lands (along roadside, railway side and canal banks)
- (2) Government wastelands.
- (3) Degraded forest lands.
- (4) vacant lands belonging to other Govt. Depts.

(B) SEMI- GOVERNMENT LAND :

1. Gaucher lands (Village Panchayat grazing lands)
2. Corporation land and belonging to other Semi-Govt. Institute

(C) PRIVATATE LAND :

1. Private lands of individuals
2. Degraded farm lands.

During the year 2014-15 the following achievements have been made under the programme of Social Forestry.

6.1 STRIP PLANTATIONS

The plantations are

6.2 GRAM VAN (IRRIGATED)

Gram Van (Irrigated) are created on village Gaucher land, 1666 seedling per hectare are to be planted on block. During the year 558 ha. of land was covered under this model.

6.3 GRAM VAN (RAIN FED)

Gram Van (Rain fed) plantation are created on village Gaucher land. No. of 1600 plants per hectare are to be planted. During the year 1850 ha. of land was covered under this model.

6.4 ENVIRONMENTAL PLANATION (E)

Air and Noise pollution near the human habitation created environmental problems. It is therefore necessary, that all the vacant lands in and around cities belonging to Corporations, Municipalities, Government's Panchayat's, School's, college's and other Institutions and also near tourist and religious places are brought under tree cover as far as possible. About 1111 seedlings per ha. are to be planted under this model at a definite spacing (5m x 5m). During the year 602 ha. of area was covered under this model.

6.5 FARM FORESTRY (FF)

Land holdings of small and marginal farmers and those of farmers belonging to scheduled tribes and scheduled castes, which are economically unsuitable for raising agriculture crops are covered under this model to supplement their income by starting an activity which can give them quick returns. Under this model, suitable trees including those of fruit are planted in the lands owned by these categories of farmers. Planting is along the field boundary, or lines so as to creates assets for the farmers. During the year under review 10659 ha. area was covered under this model.

6.6 DRIP IRRIGATION (D)

Drip Irrigation plantation are created in village Gaucher land and Barren Hillocks land. No. of 1350 plants per hectare are to be planted. During the year 501 ha. of land was covered under this model.

6.7 RIVER BANK PLANTATION

River bank plantation are created in river bank area 2500 plants per hecture are to be planted. During the year 200 ha. of land was covered under this model.

6.8 PPP (PRIVATE PUBLIC PARTNERSHIP)

PP Plantation model is under taken in individual Land were in 400 total plants per hector. Total planted during the year 2014-15, 1505 ha area was covered against target of 1500 ha.

6.9 VAN MAHOTSAVA (VNM)

Under this programme, during the year 2014-15 about 621.54 lakh seedlings have been distributed to industries, educational institutions, Government/Semi-Government agencies, farmers, religious institutions and individuals through farm forestry.

6.10 SCHOOL-KISAN NURSERY (D.C.P.)

Seedling of various species are raised by the beneficiaries under this scheme. Technical guidance and training is provided to the beneficiaries by staff of Forest department. During the year about 55.05 lakh seedlings were raised and distributed under this scheme.

6.11 SPECIAL COMPONENT PLAN (SCP)

Five models viz (1) Rehabilitation of degraded farm land (RDFL) (2) Model-E (3) Model-E Ashramshala (4) Kisan nursery and (5) Fruit tree plantation (FTP) are implemented under this programme. These schemes include beneficiaries of small & marginal farmers belonging to scheduled caste. During the year the achievements under the schemes are as under.

- (1) Under Rehabilitation of degraded farm land (RDFL) 2500 ha. of was covered
- (2) Under Model- E Environment plantation 399 ha. of was covered
- (3) Under Gramk Van Irrigated plantation 55 ha of was covered.
- (4) In Kisan Nursery, 417.50 lakh Seedling were raised and distributed.
- (5) Under Fruit tree plantation (FTP) 0.40 lakh fruit trees (seedlings) were distributed.

7 MONITORING AND EVALUATION

Monitoring and Evaluation is the most important wing of forest department for effective implementation of various activities of the forest department viz plantation and other activities. The physical verification was previously carried out by the concerned circles and division at their own choice. But it was not very effective. In order to improve this, **standing order No. 8** dated 03-02-2014 was issued by PCCF (HoFF). As per this order, now the plantations sites from 1 to 5 years are selected by this office on random basis and sent to the concerned circle for carrying out the verification. This method is very effective in creating the sensitivity of field staff for carrying out quality work. Moreover, as per the standing order 8 the monitoring of activities other than plantations are also carried by the monitoring wing.

As per the standing order no.8 a stipulated percentage of physical verification is required to carry out by officers of different ranks, related to nursery, plantations and other activities. It also prescribes the grading parameters for the nursery and plantations. The classification is different for different agro climatic zones and for different year of plantations. The different grading categories are very poor, poor, medium, good and outstanding. Similarly guidelines are prescribed for works other than nursery and plantations. For more details the standing order no 8 is provided in pdf format.

There are also suggestions and guidelines for making a successful nursery and plantations. The main aim of the monitoring and evaluation is to improve the quality of the nurseries, plantations and other activities with ultimate objective of increasing the forest and tree cover in Gujarat State.

7.1 MONITORING OF PLANTATION PROGRAMME

Tree planting being major activity of the various schemes of the project, the Monitoring and Evaluation of this plantation programme has been regularly taken up by the Monitoring & Evaluation cell of the State Forest Department on an annual basis. The results of the study are given below.

7.2 MONITORING SURVEY:

In the year 2014-15 out of total 67058 ha.of plantation raised under various schemes of the project, 3745 ha.of plantations were sampled out for Monitoring which shows that 5.58% of area was monitored and covered under the study. Samples were selected randomly from the list of model wise, site wise and year wise plantations.

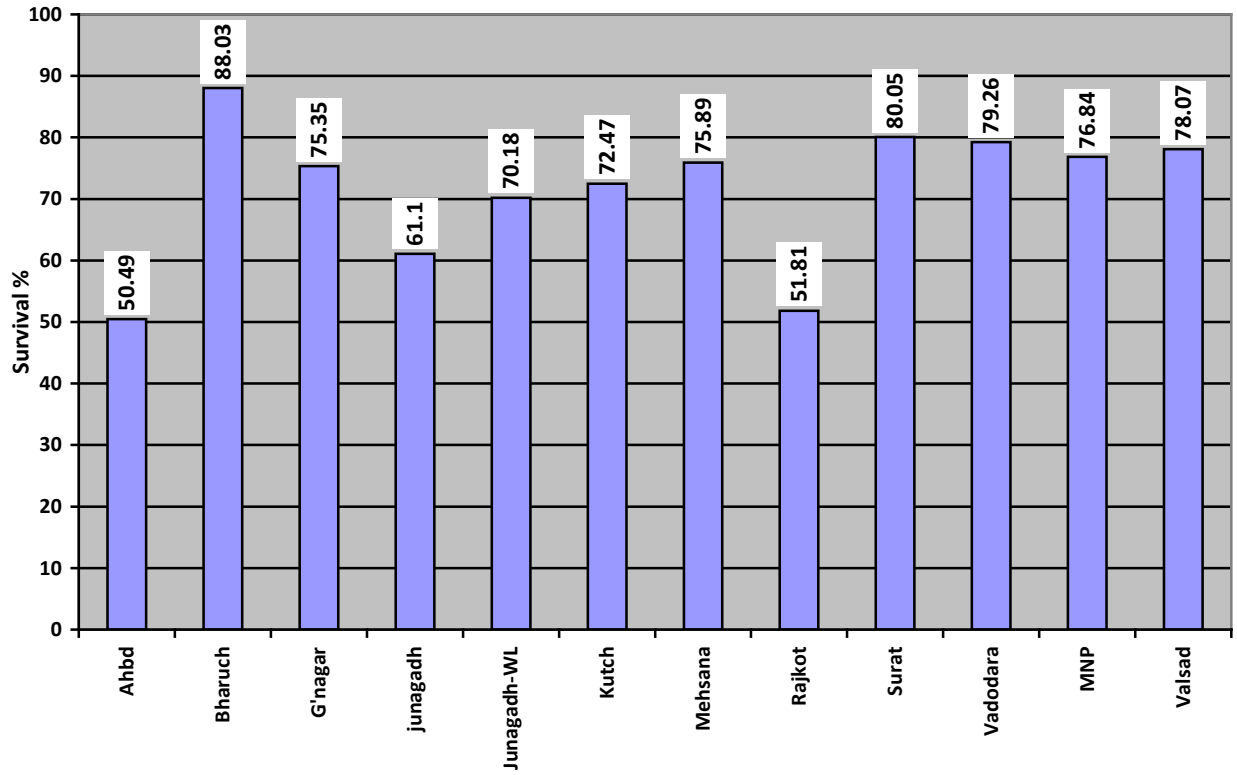
